The clerk was instructed to collect the bill against the Territory of Kansas for Rent of Rooms &c for District Court held in January 1857 for Douglas Johnson and other counties in Lawrence under a special act of the Territorial Legislature

Resolved that this County Board will pay for supplies where no contract has been made excepting fuel for the present winter cash prices with not over ten per cent added and that the clerk and sheriff when ordering said supplies shall as a part of each order notify the persons furnishing the same of this resolution

Ordered that George Ford be and he is allowed the sum of 1008 for extra services as Supervisor as Chairman of this Board

Whereas the County Board of Supervisors of this County are of the opinion that the frequent issuing of county orders when there is no money in the Treasury tends greatly to depreciate the value of such orders therefore resolved that we earnestly recommend the succeeding County Board to issue no county orders excepting at the annual meeting
