The affidavit of Mrs. Hughes in relation to illegal assessment on personal property and other proof being presented to the Board it was ordered that the tax of said Hughes for the year 1859 on \$795 the said amount having been illegally assessed be and is hereby remitted.

It was ordered that all moneys received and to be received during the present fiscal year from other sources than general taxation be and are hereby appropriated and set apart for the payment of Bonds and interest on Bonds due and owing by this County.

It was ordered that the sum of \$100- be and is hereby appropriated out of the General fund for the present year for the expenses of fuel and that the chairman and Clerk be and are hereby authorized to draw orders for the payment of bills for this purpose to said amount of \$100-

Ordered that the sum of four hundred Dollars be and is hereby appropriated towards defraying the expenses of erecting a bridge across the Wakarusa on the Leecompton and Nimicola Road subject to same conditions as contained in the resolution appropriating money for certain bridges - passed May 23. 1859
