The account of Samuel Walker for services as Sheriff Board of prisoners. Guards for prisoners etc. was allowed at \$318. to be paid out any monies not otherwise appropriated

The report of C. L. Edwards, Co. School Superintendent for year ending Dec 31, 1859, was presented and accepted by the Board

Ordered that \$1 be allowed for Postage Stamps and that a warrant be drawn for the same payable out of any monies not otherwise appropriated
