

on the first day of December and first day of June in each year. Said bonds ^{and coupons} shall be attested in behalf of this county by the Chairman of this Board and the County Clerk and countersigned by the County Treasurer.

That in accordance with the contract with C. M. Valleau & Co. for the erection of said jail on the completion of said contract. the acceptance of this Board by the said C. M. Valleau & Co. or their agents or assigns the bonds of this County shall be issued and delivered to the said C. M. Valleau & Co. to the amount of \$14,826.80 in sums of 100\$ each payable in the City of Lawrence, as follows:

One fourth of said amount payable on the first day of June 1862
 One fourth of said amount payable on the first day of June 1863
 One fourth of said amount payable on the first day of June 1864
 One fourth of said amount payable on the first day of June 1865
 on the surrender of said bonds with interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum to be paid on the presentation and delivery of warrant or coupon to be annexed to said bonds and payable semiannually on the first day of December and first day of June in each year. Said bonds and coupons shall be attested in behalf of this County by the Chairman of this Board and the County Clerk and countersigned by the County Treasurer provided if said contract be completed sooner or later than the fifteenth of August, 1860, that said amount of 14826.80 shall be changed to conform to the spirit of said contract and provided that bonds for a less amount than 100- each may be issued - a sufficient number to make the amount of bonds authorized to be issued in the foregoing order and that the amount of coupons attached to said bonds of a less amount than \$100 shall be made to conform therewith.

Ordered that the County Clerk be authorized and instructed to procure a sufficient number of blank bonds for the purpose of the foregoing order.

Ordered that Sumner Sampson be and is hereby instructed to negotiate the sale of the above amount of \$2673.20 in County bonds at not less than 85 cents on the dollar.

Ordered that the Clerk of this Board do notify C. M. Valleau & Co. of the acceptance by this Board of the proposition of said Valleau & Co. in relation to jail contract.
