We the undersigned commissioners appointed by the honorable Board of Douglas County to view and survey a road from the town of Bloomington south to intersect the Marion and Lawrence road as more fully set forth in the order of said Board met at Bloomington agreeably to appointment on the 7th day of May 1860 where we were met by D. H. Leach the county surveyor and after first being duly sworn took to our assistance E. Stokes and Christian Koon as chain carriers and proceeded to view and survey said road and would report to the honorable County Board that in the opinion of your commissioners a road as prayed for in the petition of E. Stokes and others is needed by the residents and the travelling public and that a good road can be obtained by a slight deviation in one place from the range line between Township 13. Range 18. and Township 13. Range 19 at a reasonable expense that the owners of the land will claim no damages for the right of way and that in the opinion of your commissioners said road should be laid out 40 feet in width for further particulars see accompanying plat and field notes

It appearing that the proceedings in relation to the location of said road have been made according to law it is ordered that said ^{road} be and is hereby located and established

It is ordered that the line appointed for the survey by A. D. Leach of a road in Endora Township commencing at the point in Section two (2) of township thirteen (13) Range twenty one (21) where the Shawnee and Decoto road intersects the line of demarkation between the counties Johnson and Douglas thence to lead in a westerly direction through the sections three (3) and four (4) of the same town and range to the east line of Endora city at or about 9th street of said city be extended to June 14. 1860

The petition of R. C. Bishop for license to keep a ferry at Leamington being presented and the Board believing said ferry to be necessary for the accommodation of the public, and that the petitioner is a suitable person to keep the same, it is ordered that the Clerk of this Board do issue a license as aforesaid upon the payment of a tax of \$50 and it is further ordered that the said Bishop give bond according
