Ordered that the window sills of the flank windows for the jail shall be of black walnut

The bond of Eliza Johnson and Paul for the faithful completion of their contract with this Board for the erection of Jail so was approved by the Board

Ordered that Mr. Sampson be and is hereby appointed a committee of this Board to act for and on behalf of this Board where he shall deem it necessary for the carrying out of the contract for the jail other than the iron work and to draw the money for the payment of the same according to contract
