

and Austin Dean disinterested landholders of the township in which said proposed roads be appointed as jurors and D. S. Reabody be appointed as surveyor to view said road and locate the same according to law on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of Aug 1860

It is further ordered that if there should be any greater amount of damages claimed for land than the county now are liable for that the commissioners be and are hereby instructed to report adversely to the prayer of the petitioners

The trustee of Willow Springs township C. B. Steele being present, it is ordered that this board do advise and concur with said trustee in levying a tax on the property of the citizens of said township for township road and incidental expenses of said township as follows -

For Willow Spring Township, (\$200) Two hundred dollars

We the undersigned jurors appointed by the Board of Commissioners of County Douglas having been duly sworn did not on the twenty first day of July instant view the road now located from the north east corner of section 21. on a direct line to the south east corner of Audora Townsite and the road proposed as laid down in the accompanying survey and we recommend the above mentioned road now located be vacated and that one of the widths of three rods be established on the line of the accompanying survey and we adjudge no damages to the owners of the property on which it passes
