

same it is ordered that the Clerk do issue a license to the said R. C. Bishop for one year from the date of the commencement of said ferry upon the payment of \$10 Tax in cash

The Bond of said R. C. Bishop shall be in the sum of \$1000

The petition of John Baldwin for license to keep a ferry at the Kansas River at Lawrence for one year from the 28th day of August 1860 was presented and the Board Relieving said ferry necessary for the accommodation of the public and that the petitioner is a suitable person to keep the same it is ordered that the Clerk do issue a license to the said John Baldwin in accordance with said petition upon the payment of \$1.75 and that the amount of bond of John Baldwin as keeper of said ferry shall be in the sum of ~~200~~ Thousand Dollars

It was ordered that the County Attorney be instructed to take such legal steps as he may deem necessary in relation to the nonpayment by Deomunkel. of any license for the ferry at Leecompton for the year ending July 20th 1860 and for the year commencing July 20th 1860 and that the license for said ferry for the year commencing July 20th 1860 shall be \$38 in cash

The Board adjourned
till Monday August 27th 1860
