The Board proceeded to examine the assess-
ment roll of the year 1860 and to equalize the
valuation of the real estate &c according to
law

It was ordered that the following changes
on said roll be made to wit

That all the tracts and lots of land lying within
the boundaries of Eudora township excepting town-
lots shall be ~~raised~~ ^{reduced} in valuation 17 o/o or to
\$5.24+ per acre on an average

That the valuation of all the tracts and lots of land
lying within the boundaries of Leamington township
excepting town lots shall be raised 15 o/o or to an
average valuation of \$5.23+ per acre
