The report of the Commissioners appointed
to view a route for a certain road in Waka-
nusa Township reported as follows:

The Honorable Board of Commis-
sioners of Douglas County

Wet the undersigned com-
missioners appointed to view a route for a road
from some point west of J. Brandon's dwelling
house on what is known as the Bottom road
in a southerly direction by Dr. Barker's dwelling
house to intersect the so called middle road
beg leave to report after having been first duly
qualified have viewed the said route and find it
practicable and much needed by the commu-
nity and we have this day located said
road as laid down in the accompanying
field notes and plat. We have laid said road
two rods wide and made no award for land
damages all of which we most respectfully
submit

to and made a part of said report
