The petition of Wm Meair and others for a township road and for the discontinuance of a township road as follows

We the undersigned residents of Wakarusa township Douglas Co Kansas Territory pray the County Commissioners to locate at their July session on the following line to wit commencing at a point on the township line between ranges 19 & 20, township 13 range 19 and running west on said section line to a point on the north side of the N.E. gr of Sec. 28 township 13, range 19 where a township road intersects said north line & to discontinue a road heretofore laid out but not worked running East & west through the center of aforesaid sec 24.

Wm Meair, L. W. Hooper, O. P. Kennedy, H. Kennedy, J. R. Kennedy, C. Holloway, S. Watts, J. M. Hellstrom, Edmund Quless, W. H. Carley, S. G. Tolson, E. E. Griffiths, Edward Winslow, S. J. Kennedy, J. M. Shepherd for opening against him, Harry Bush, J. R. Stubbs, being presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County and the board being satisfied that proper notice of the presentation of said petition has been given and the petitioners entering into bond with sufficient security according to law to the satisfaction of the board and the petition being read in open meeting of the board and the board being satisfied that such proposed road <sup>as the commissioners</sup> is necessary it is ordered that J. Marshall, Chas Dickson and H. Dunbar disinterested landholders of the township in which said road and proposed road runs be appointed as jurors and Chas Dickson as Surveyor to rework said road and locate and discontinue the same according to law on the 10<sup>th</sup> day September 1860
