The petition of Dona Miner and others for a change in a certain road was presented - as follows

To the Hon County Board of Douglas County Greeting We the undersigned would respectfully petition your honorable body to change the road running from Clinton to New Haven so as to make the same run on the following route from a point north of Joseph Eberhart's house on the most practicable route through the woods to the foot of the bluff in a northerly direction; thence along the foot of the bluff to the Appleman east line thence north along said line to the foot of the bluff again thence along the foot of said bluff to the township line between Miller Springs and Lawrence Townships

(Signed) Dona Miner, Edward Jones and others and the Board being satisfied that proper notice of the presentation of said petition has been given and the petitioners entering into bonds with sufficient securities according to law to the satisfaction of the Board and the petition being read in open meeting of the Board and the Board being satisfied that such proposed change is necessary it is ordered that E. Dickson, Jos. Eberhart and Jacob Wrick be and are hereby appointed as jurors and Chas.
