The petition of J. C. Skele and others for a vacation of a portion of the Territorial road from Lawrence to Emporia was presented as follows:

To the commissioners of Douglas County Ks.
We the undersigned citizens of Douglas County do hereby petition your body now in session for an alteration of so much of the Territorial road leading from Lawrence to Emporia as you will see set forth in this petition from Lake Bridge the most practicable route to the town site of Bloomington thence through said town commencing at the east end of Neosho Avenue thence westerly through said town the most practicable route leaving said town at the west end of Crag Avenue thence westerly the most practicable route through the town of Clinton until it will intersect said road again. Also to vacate that part of the county road known as the Clinton and New Haven road from the south east corner of Clinton to the south west corner of Bloomington And we your petitioners will ever pray
