 ing to the board that proper notice of the appli-
 cation not having been posted, it was ordered that
 the order appointing jurors and surveyor to view
 said road be and is hereby rescinded

Report of Commissioners appointed to view a
 certain road petitioned for by Andrew White and
 others

In the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas
 County Kansas

We the undersigned having been appointed and
 duly sworn as Commissioners and surveyor to
 view a certain road on petition of Andrew White
 and others as follows viz beginning at the north east
 corner of the town of Bloomington thence east on the
 section line or as near as practicable between the
 sections 18 & 19, 17 & 20 &c continuing on said line
 crossing the Lawrence and Marion road till it
 intersects the Minneda and Lawrence road and there
 to terminate

would hereby report
 that we have viewed the said route and are of
 the opinion that the prayer of the petitioners
 should be granted. There being no continuous road
 east & west either north or south of this line for many
 miles the travel of the Wakarusa valley in that
 direction is not now accommodated and many
 inhabitants have no road connected with the rest
 of roads already located running to Lawrence
 and further as the road asked for intersects some
 of these roads that are not bridged across the
 Wakarusa creek in case of high water in that stream
 the travel could diverge and cross at the bridges
 already constructed. We therefore have and do
 hereby locate and have surveyed and marked the said
 road sixty feet wide as follows commencing at a
 point on the township line between Range 18 and 19
 eighteen and nineteen at the corners of sections 18
