It was ordered that said report and plat and  
field notes be accepted and adopted and that  
the same be filed

In the matter of the road petitioned for by  
Jonathan Miner and others

The jurors appended to view said road  
reported as follows:

To the Board of County Commissioners of  
Douglas County Kansas Ter.

We the undersigned, having been appointed  
and duly sworn as jurors and surveyors, to view a  
change asked for in a certain road as follows viz:  
the road running from Clinton to New Haven so as  
to make the same run on the following route from  
a point north of Jos. Elsharts house on the most  
practicable route through the woods to the foot of the  
bluff in a northerly direction thence along the  
foot of the bluff to the Applemans east line thence  
north along said line to the foot of the bluff again  
thence along the foot of said bluff to the township  
line between Willow Springs and Lawrence townships

Do hereby leave to report

That we have viewed the said road and route and  
decide that the change asked for should be made  
for the following reasons, 1<sup>st</sup> a much easier grade  
up the bluff can be obtained by the new route

2<sup>d</sup> the damage to farms passed through would be  
very much less

3<sup>d</sup> all the inhabitants accommodated by the old  
route and several who are not would be by the new  
and 4<sup>th</sup> Mr. Miner will be saved the expense and  
trouble of moving some 2 1/4 of a mile of rock fence  
for the benefit of no one

We do therefore hereby  
change the said road so as to run as follows

Commencing at a point north of Jos Elsharts house  
and running westerly twenty rods and so as to  
make the whole width of the road on said Elsharts  
land thence north westerly along the side of the  
bluff to the foot near where it meets the east line  
of the south east quarter of section three of township
