

thirteen in range nineteen thence along the foot of the bluff and to the west line of said quarter section thence northerly along said line to the foot of the bluff again thence northwesterly along the foot of the bluff and to the township line between Miller Springs and Wakarusa townships.

The said route having been surveyed and marked according to law and as shown by the annexed plat.

We decide that no damages shall be allowed to the owners of the land through which said road shall pass.

Ordered that the County attorney be requested to ascertain how much fine money has been collected by H. Burson Justice of the Peace belonging to the County the matter of the allowance made to H. Burson as per Treasurers Report for making returns of fines was referred to County attorney

Ordered that the County Treasurer be authorized to receive ferry license of John Baldwin at Lawrence Jerome Kunkel at Leecompton and R. C. Bishop near Leecompton in Sou. and that upon the refusal or neglect of said parties to pay said license as aforesaid that the Co. Atty. be and is hereby instructed to take charge of the collection of said license money

The resignation of J. H. Thompson as constable of Clinton township was presented and accepted

The petition of Horace Hancock for remitting the tax assessed for the present year on his personal property was granted

Ordered that all appropriations made in the year 1859/60 not used be cancelled

Whereas J. C. Steele the Justice of Clinton Township and John S. Moore one of the Road masters of said township are absent & likely to remain so for some time to come and whereas there is some road work very necessary to be immediately performed in the road district over which J. S. Moore aforesaid was appointed
