 to lay out and establish a county road beginning
 at the north east corner of the north east quarter of
 section three township 12 Range 18 on the south line
 of Greenup thence in a southeasterly course inter-
 secting the before mentioned road in section 13, Town-
 ship 12 Range 18 being presented and the Board being
 satisfied that proper notice of the presentation of said
 petition has been given and the petitioners entering
 into bonds with sufficient securities according to
 law to the satisfaction of the Board and the pe-
 tion being read in open meeting of the Board and
 the Board being satisfied that such proposed road
 change is necessary it is ordered that N. M. M. M.
 G. L. Linn and M. M. C. C. be appointed Com-
 missioners and David D. Mitchell as surveyor to view
 said road and proposed change on the 21st of Janu-
 ary 1861.
