Resolved that the Clerk be instructed to forward forthwith a copy of said resolution to the Governor Secretary the presiding officers of each house and to the judges of the Supreme Court

Resolved that the Co Treasurer be and is hereby instructed to lay aside all moneys received by him for ferry licenses and for other purposes not heretofore appropriated as a contingent fund for the payment of expenses necessarily to be paid in cash and that all moneys received during the present year not heretofore appropriated for similar fund or other purposes be and are hereby appropriated to said Contingent fund

Ordered that the order passed Oct 30 1860 authorizing the County Treasurer to receive certain ferry licenses in County & rip be and is hereby rescinded the parties having failed to pay said licenses

Ordered that the County attorney be and is hereby instructed to collect by law ferry license and to take such other measures for the enforcement of law in the matter as he may deem necessary
