

Bond of Amos Hicks Justice of the Peace with Ralph E. Johnson and Wm. H. Hammond as securities was approved

Bond of Wm. McKimney Justice of the Peace of Leecompton Township with Wm. Brindle and Wm. J. McKimney as securities was approved

Ordered that a road tax of five mills on the dollar is hereby levied on all the lands in Douglas County subject to taxation for the year 1860/61 without including the improvements thereon

The petition of R. C. Bishop for license to run a ferry at the town of Leecompton on the Kansas River below the mouth of Washbopper Creek was granted for one year from the day of February 1861 at the rate of \$10. per annum and the Bond of said R. C. Bishop with D. S. McDutchie as security was approved and the rates of ferriage were fixed at the same as the rates fixed for the ferry at Lawrence by the Board of Co-Superior on the 28th day of August 1858

Resolved that the County Attorney is hereby instructed to take such steps in behalf of the County as may be necessary in regard to the Baldwin Ferry at Lawrence touching the payment of license, giving of bonds and the rights of said Baldwin by charter or otherwise to run said ferry as the interests of the County may require

The account of Wm. H. Hayden as Co. Comm & Conmaster was allowed at \$22.60

The account of S. H. Leason as Co. Comm was allowed at \$12.00
