15 and 22 of the Town and Range aforesaid to the N.W. corner of said Sec. 22, 1/4 of said Sec. 22,
and from thence by the best and most practicable route in a westerly direction to
the Lawrence and LeCompton road, being presented and the Board being satisfied that
proper notice of the presentation of said petition has been given and the petitioners enter-
ing into bonds with sufficient securities according to law to the satisfaction of the Board,
and the Board being satisfied that such proposed road is necessary— it is ordered that
Hiram Dunbar, Josiah Houghton and Osa Dutton be appointed as viewers and D. L.
Peabody as Surveyor to view and locate said road according to law on Monday July
