The petition of Ebenezer Disbrow and others for a Township road beginning at the South west corner of the North East quarter of Section 18 Township 13 Range 18 (the terminus of a road running from the North) to now to the Northwest corner of the North East quarter of Section 31 Town 13 Range 18 in the town of Clinton and leading in a southerly direction to the aforesaid point being presented and the Board being satisfied that proper notice of the presentation of said petition has been given, and the petitioners entering into bonds with sufficient securities according to law to the satisfaction of the Board, and the Board being satisfied that such proposed road is necessary—it is ordered that Jonathan Copeland, William Hemborg and Richard Leavitt be appointed as commissioners and D. H. Peabody as Surveyor to view and locate said road according to law on Tuesday July 23rd A. D. 1861.
