

Louis T. Litchfield Bailiff District Court November Term 1860

Ch. 107

Resolved that hereafter all jurors and witnesses will be required to present a certificate of the clerk of District Court with seal of said Court attached giving the number of days in attendance and miles travelled before the Board will audit the same payment, and that no bills of jurors and witnesses will hereafter be allowed in the bills presented by the clerk of District Court.

The petition of Daniel Stuebelius and others for a Township road, commencing at the south west corner of Section 34, Town fourteen Range nineteen, running thence east on or near the line one mile and a quarter - thence south to or near the southwest corner of the North east quarter of Section eight Town fourteen Range nineteen - thence east one quarter of a mile to intersect a Township Road running south being presented and the Board being satisfied that proper notice of the presentation of said petition has been given and the petitioners entering into bonds with sufficient securities according to law to the satisfaction of the Board - and the Board being satisfied that such proposed road is necessary, it is ordered that Messrs. Van Housen, Jacob H. Willems and John Pearce be appointed as commissioners and Daniel Hubbard as surveyor to run and locate said road according to law - for Tuesday July 16th 1861.

The Trustees of the following Townships having communicated with this Board in relation to the amount necessary to defray Township and incidental expenses for their respective Townships for the ensuing year - it is ordered that this Board do concur with the Trustees of said Townships in levying a tax on the property of the citizens of their respective Townships for Township, Road, and incidental expenses of said Township as follows -

Ordered that the clerk notify the balance of Township Trustees to appear before the Board of County Commissioners on Monday the 19th day of August 1861 at an adjourned meeting of this Board.
