We the undersigned having been appointed by the County Board of Douglas County to view a Township road in Willow Springs Township prayed for by Stephen Stuebaker and others to commence at S. W. corner of Sec. 6. Town 14 Range 19 running thence East on or near the line one mile and a quarter thence South to or near the South West corner of the S. E. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 8. Town 14 Range 19 thence E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile to intersect a Township road running South makes the following report. We met at the house of Jacob Harkley on the 16th of July 1861 and after having been sworn to the faithful discharge of duty passed over said route as designated above and examined the same carefully and we are of the opinion that a road ought not to be located on said route.

It was ordered that said report be accepted and that the same be placed on file.
