The petition of S. C. Chalker and others that more strict and rigid discipline be enforced in the keeping of county prisoners, and the Board having the same under consideration would recommend that the Sheriff enforce strict discipline in the safe keeping of prisoners under his charge and that he confine the prisoners in the cells and not permit them to have the liberty of the halls of the jail.
