Jones and H. Simpson and R. Miller to the lands of Green Luzzor and R. Gentry — thence
on one or both of the lands of said Luzzor and Gentry to the Barker road on the west
land of the old numbered — Also to lay out and establish a Township Road beginning in
the above described route for a road at the aforesaid N.E. corner of section fifteen and running
thence north one mile on the line between James Christian and H. Simpson and between
L.O. Shucker and Mabel T. Moore to the new road running west towards Leocompton being
presented to the Board and the Board being satisfied that proper notice of the presentation
of said petition has been given and the petitioners entering into bonds with sufficient sureties ac-
cording to law to the satisfaction of the Board and the Board being satisfied that such propo-
sed road is necessary — it is ordered that Asa Dutton Hiram Dunbar and Philip Hutchin-
son be appointed as commissioners and D. L. Babcock Surveyor to view and locate said road
according to law on Thursday October 17th 1861.

The petition of J. H. Gleason and others for a Township road upon the half section line of
Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 of Township 14 Range 19 or as near thereon as a good road can be
located being presented to the Board and the Board being satisfied that proper notice of the
presentation of said petition has been given and the petitioners entering into bonds with sufficient
sureties according to law to the satisfaction of the Board and the Board being satisfied that
such proposed is necessary — it is ordered that Jacob Marshall, Jacob Ulrich and John Hagley
be appointed as commissioners and D. L. Babcock as Surveyor to view and locate said road
according to law on Monday October 21st 1861.

The petition of C. L. Moore praying that tax on Lots 21, 22 and 23 in Block 20 and
Lot 15 in Block 22 in the City of Leocompton sold to John Reising in 1859 be refunded
to purchaser the same having been incorrectly assessed — it is ordered

The Board proceeded to estimate and determine the amount of money to be raised by
tax for County purposes — for the support of common schools and for the payment of the Bonds
and interest of the County falling due during the present year for the current year —
and it was ordered that there be levies and collected for said purposes from the several
persons and property subject to taxation in this County as returned by the Assessor as follows
