Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment

and H. Shanklin, County Clerk

On motion J. Gleason was appointed chairman *pro tem*

The resignation of Turner Sampson Chairman of Board of County Commissioners being presented— it was *received*

Resolved That the resignation of Turner Sampson be accepted and the clerk ordered to place the same on file

Resignation of H. C. Blood Justice of the Peace of Palmyra Township be accepted and the same placed on file

Panel of S. A. Carmean Constable of Palmyra Township with H. C. Blood and J. W. Vaughn as justices was appointed
