It was ordered that from and after November 11th 1861 the rates of ferryage for the Lawrence Ferry shall be as follows viz:-

For 2 Horses and vehicle	25 ^{cts}
" 1 yoke of cattle and wagon	25 "
" each yoke " or horse	15 "
" 1 Horse and chaise, buggy or wagon	25 "
" 1 Horse and rider	15 "
" Cattle per head	5 "
" Sheep and swine per head	2 "
" Footman each	5 "

From 10 o'clock P. M. to 4 o'clock A. M. double the above rates are allowed.

Ordered that the County Clerk notify the proprietors of Lawrence Ferry of the action of the Board in relation to said ferry.
