Monday of April A.D. 1862 as provided by law, and organized by F. Gleason
taking the chair

The first thing in order before the Board, was the consideration
of the claim of J. W. Wakefield for \$300. damages sustained by the location of
a Territorial Road through his farm in the summer of 1859 pending the consi-
deration of which the Board adjourned until 1 o'clock P.M.

The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment
present F. Gleason Chairman, and C. Dickson John E. Cornbell Commissioners
The consideration of Judge Wakefield claim for damages deferred until
tomorrow

The Bill of W. R. Davis County School Superintendent was pres-
ented and referred back for a detailed statement of services rendered

W. G. Peper's annual Report as Trustee of Pulmony Township was ac-
cepted asking the best he could make under the circumstances of
his office (appointment)

Upon application of Thomas Peisons for a statement
of Tax upon personal property it was ordered that \$13.⁰⁰ be abated

D. S. Rabony presented his resignation of the office of County Surveyor
which was accepted

Daniel Hubbard was appointed to fill the vacancy
in the office of County Surveyor occasioned by the failure of Thomas Peipers
to qualify within the time prescribed by law

The resignation of L. S. Schumacher
of the office of Justice of the Peace of Cudora Township accepted.

Judge Wakefield claim for Road damages withdrawn
