The Road described in the above Petition, as commencing at the West line
of the Town of Deerpark in Deerpark County State of Kansas, thence West and near
the Kansas River to the West line of Deerpark Township.

Township 13 Range 17. Rejected. Put upon the 18th of Section 8. Twp
12. Range 19 the sum of \$3.33 was added.
