Petition for Road in Mauckanusa Township

Presented by W. Thatcher and C. Talley adopted and J. H. Grier, P. H. Hutchinson and J. A. Patton appointed viewers and J. H. Grier Surveyor to meet at the House of M. Elkhart on the 25th day of April at 10 o'clock A.M. The Road described in the Petition as follows: Commencing North East corner of the South West Quarter of Section 10 in said Township 13 Range 17

Report of L. G. Ralphy Surveyor of Road Surveyed by him in Clinton Township Surveyed for by Elmer S. Shaw and others adopted thereby establishing the said Road. The above Road is described as follows by the said Surveyor: This note of a Road Surveyed under the direction of Richard Crocker Commencing at the SE corner of NE Quarter of Section 13-13-18 West one mile and partly rolling prairie to the NW corner of the NW Quarter of said Sec 13 West one mile and through high prairie to the NW corner of the NW Quarter of Sec 13-13-17. With one half mile on Robert Carsons East line to divide prairie and accommodate the settlers to the NW corner of said Section 13 up grade slope. West one mile and rolling high prairie between Sections 11-16 and 13-14 to the first line of said County of Carroll. Whole distance there and one half miles. Width of Road Sixty Feet

 Petitioners adopted, John W. Emms, J. W. Whipple and William Carless appointed viewers, J. H. Grier Surveyor to meet at the House of William Carless on the 5th day of May at 9 o'clock A.M.

The above Road described in the Petition as follows: Commencing at a point 40 rods East of the NW corner of Section 24 Township 13 Range 19 in Mauckanusa Township thence running with the Bluff Southern until it strikes the NW corner of Sec 24 Township 13 Range 19 thence due South as near as practicable on the Section line to the South line of the Township the said Road to strike said points as near as the nature of the ground will permit

C. Dickson and John E. Lambie appointed a committee to examine the Bridge which crosses the Mauckanusa creek near P. H. Hutchinson Reported the Bridge to be recently repaired in a good and substantial manner
