The 1st The Voters appointed last April to view a Road in Accompton Township failed to comply with the terms of the appointment, and made application for the appointment of September 22nd as the day they should meet pursuant the Road was prayed for by Wiley Smith and others.

The 2nd The Board with the concurrence of the Trustees of Accompton Township levied a Tax of \$150.⁰⁰ on the Township for Township purposes.

" 3 The Board appropriated \$100.⁰⁰ for necessary repairs on the County Jail to be done and used by the Sheriff Henry Brown.

" 4 " The Board with the concurrence of the Trustees of Eudora Township, levied a Tax of 2¹/₂ cts on each \$1.⁰⁰ worth of property of Eudora Township for Township purposes.

" 5 The Jury Book, was examined by the Board to ascertain what number of Jury hours have forfeited to the County, and finally the matters were referred to the County Clerk with instructions to report at the next meeting.

" 6 " Ordered, that the District Attorney, James A. Rice be requested the legal steps to collect the amount of money, formerly collected by Sheriff Walker pursuant to an order of the County Board issued Page 167 of the Book of proceedings of the said Board.

" 7 " W. S. McCurdy returned 3 Certificates of Land Sales to the amount of 27⁰⁰ interest inclusive making 30⁰⁰ to be issued on Sept at the

" 8 " W. G. Peper, Trustee of Palm Springs Township applied for \$200.⁰⁰ Tax on the Township for Township purposes. Ordered that that sum be levied.

" 9 The Bill of J. H. Brown, Charles Dickson, and John C. Combs for services as County Commissioners for the Jan. April, and July meetings were audited \$42.⁰⁰ each.

" 10 Ordered, that the Clerk notify the County Treasurer of the passage in relation to the Contingent Fund.
