

Field Notes of a Road surveyed by David Keuthard County Surveyor in Marion Township in connection with Robert McFarland, Geo. N. Goss and Thomas Shelton Viewers on the 28th day of July 1862. Apparently to notice on the said day went to the house of J. M. Mayo and proceeded with the above named Viewers all being first duly sworn to Survey the following Road commencing at a Stake standing in the East $\frac{1}{4}$ line of the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15 Township 12 Range 19. said Stake being 115 Rods N. from the South East corner of the above described Section and thence 3 chains to top of Bluff down Bluff and over Bottoms to another Stake said stake being 2 Rods S. of a small Brook which is a good crossing, up a slight ascent to angle stake through brush to a Stake in the road that crosses a ford in the Lake said stake being on the Bank of said Lake In the above Survey my compass was set at a variation $10^{\circ} 30' E$

Viewers appointed by your body to view a Road in Marion Township in said County proposed for by Jacob R. Smith and others met agreeably to notice on the 21st day of July A.D. 1862 at the house of John Young and after first being duly sworn proceeded to view the route proposed, and regarding said proposal well necessary and practicable, report favorably and recommend the same to be located Four Rods in width and as set forth in the Field Notes and Plat of Survey made in accordance with our direction by David Keuthard, County Surveyor on the 21st day of July 1862

Apparently to notice on the said day went to the house of John Young and proceeded with the above named all being first duly sworn to survey the following road commencing at the North East corner of Section 26 Group 19 Range 18th over rolling prairie on Section line dividing Sections 25 and 26 and 26 and 25 and the East $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 27 and 34 to a Rock in the middle of line dividing Sections 27 and 34 The Road to be Four Rods wide
