The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment.

7th The County Treasurer presented a List of County Orders for cancellation
which were referred to the October meeting of the Board of Commissioners

8th The Resignation of Wm. S. Wakefield of the Office of Trustee of Hancock
Township was presented by Mr. Wakefield and accepted,

9th The Bill of C. L. Mandall for Services as jailor from the 21st of May
to the 7th of July 1862 injected upon the ground that Henry Broder
Sheriff was paid for this same thing at the July meeting of the
Board

10th Wm. G. Soule's Bill for attendance as Bailiff on the District

11th Bill of Wm. G. Soule for watching jail from 7 days up to July 2nd 1862
laid over to the October meeting for information.

city Auditor audited at \$80.⁰⁰ Amount claimed \$105.⁰⁰
