 The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to law, F. H. Gleason, Chas. Dickson and John Campbell present

Edward Garner, made application under oath for abatement of assessment of Personal Property, which application was granted to the amount of 200⁰⁰

C. P. Pittingill made application for additional allowance upon his bill for services as Deputy County Assessor for 1862 which was rejected

A Petition for the change of Boundaries of School District No 7 Mallow-Springe Township, was presented and upon consideration of which the Board Ordered that Section 15 Township 15 Range 14 be and remain part of said district

The matter of settlement with the County for Two Strykers taken up by O. P. Curry having been referred by the County Treasurer to the Board of County Commissioners was adjusted by the taking up of said Strygs saying One half the appraised value deducting the expenses pertaining to the taking the said Strygs — and that nothing be allowed for keeping said Strygs.

L. A. Dennis made application under oath for abatement of assessment upon his Personal Property to the amount of \$785⁰⁰ which was granted

The Board read publicly the Report of the Viewers of a County Road proposed for by S. H. Garner David Scultane Pler Ordeler and others as the law directs

On motion the following order was made, That the District Attorney take the proper legal proceedings to collect the money due the County from the use of Prisons in said County, especially the the Army established at the City of Sauwnee by One John. Baldwin & Company

On motion the Board adjourned until tomorrow morning 8 o'clock a.m.
