The Road Viewers Report of Road proposed for by W. Joseph, S. B. Harris and others read and approved and the said Road pronounced established in accordance with said Report provided no damages be allowed in consequence of said location, and that the field notes and Plats of said Road be placed on file. The said Report was in the words following to wit:

To the County Commissioners in and for Douglas County Kansas.

We the undersigned appointed by your Board to view and report on a Road petitioned for by W. Joseph, S. B. Harris, W. R. Wrenniff and others met at the Store of W. W. Breckinridge on Tuesday October 21st 9 o'clock A.M. and after taking duly sworn procedure to view the Road as described by your Board viz: Commencing at the Santa Fe Road in Section Seven (7) Township 15. Range 21. at the North East corner of the Town site of Black Jack and running thence North on the section line between Sections 17 & 18 in Township 15. Range 21, to when it intersects the Township line between Townships 15, 16, 17 & 18. In the opinion of the undersigned the section of through which said Road passes is well adapted for a road passes is with a small expense for the same - also it would be great advantage to the inhabitants not only on the line of the road but to the traveling community in general said Road to be four Rods wide in our opinion W. W. Ward on Section 6 Township 15 Range 21, should be entitled to \$28.00 damages for Since &c. Chas. Galletty on S.W. 1/4 of Section 5 Township 15. Range 21 \$18.00 no other claims damages on said Road all of which is respectfully submitted
