

A Petition was presented for the Vacation of a Territorial Road running through MacKenzie Township by M^r Fitch and Savage, which was with disavow for the reasons indicated in reference to Dr Martin's Pet.

A Petition was presented by James Shaw Oldham and others for the location of a Township Road in Kananaskis Township which was approved and Capt Thomas Dickerton, Geo W Corley and Aaron E. Platts appointed Viewers to view the proposed route and to locate the said Road if the public interest required it and Hollander Wheeler the County Surveyor was appointed to make the Survey of the said road under the direction of said Viewers. The said Viewers and Surveyor, are ordered to meet at the House of the said Petitioner James Shaw Oldham on the 21st day of April A.D. 1863 at 9 o'clock A.M. The said Petition is in the words and figures following to wit: Commencing at the NW corner of Section Thirty six (36), Township T12, Range S17, this being at the Nat. line of Douglas County running East on or near the North line of Section Thirty five (35), North West Quarter of Section 36 Township T12, Range S17, and West half of North East Quarter of Section Thirty six (36), Township T12, Range S17, thence and line through East half of North East Quarter of Section Thirty six (36), Township T12, Range S17, thence in a South East course through Section Thirty one (31), to center of Section Thirty (30), thence on or near the line through Sections Thirty three (33), Thirty four (34), T12, Thirty five (35) Thirty six (36) to section Thirty three (33), Range S17, Township T12,

A Petition was presented for the location of Road in Kananaskis Township by Samuel Buchheim and others which was approved and Capt Thomas Dickerton, Geo W Corley, and Aaron E. Platts appointed Viewers to view and locate said road in accordance with said petition should the public interest require it. and Hollander Wheeler County Surveyor, appointed to make the Survey of said road under the direction of the said Viewers. The said Viewers and Surveyor are ordered to meet at the House of the said petitioner Samuel Buchheim on the 20th day of April A.D. 1863 at 9 o'clock A.M. and proceed to make said view and survey. The petition for said Road is in the words and figures following to wit: We the undersigned, petitioners and Owners of land along and near the line of the road hereafter proposed to be located, would most respectfully petition the Hon^{ble} Board of County Commissioners to locate a Road as follows (Commencing at a point in the South line of the SW 1/4 of Section 27 Twenty five (25), Township T12, Range S17, where the said line from Scurmont to Topshoe turns North running thence from said point West on the Section line to the West line of Douglas County intersecting said West line of Douglas County at the SW Corner of the SW Quarter of Section Twenty six Township T12, Range S17, and your petitioners would ever pray &c
