

Known E. Hatt's account for one years service as Township Trustee of Kennebec Township \$150.00. One years service \$25.00, Town Miller Township Trustee Monroe Township. J. S. Mitchell's account as Township Trustee Seecompton Township audited at \$28.20, \$9.60 deducted being the amount which was charged in said Bill for mileage, which is not allowed in the law for the services of Township Trustees.

The following Resolutions were passed to wit: That the Buildings upon the Lot, known as the lot which the City Council of the City of Searsville, ceded to the County of Douglas for County purposes said lot being bounded as follows to wit: Massachusetts Street on the East by Pinkney Street on the South, by Vermont Street on the West, and by the Kansas River on the North, be removed; and that the owners and occupants of said Buildings be notified by the Sheriff of Douglas County to remove the same, and that said building be removed by said owners and occupants within thirty days from the date of the service of this notice under the penalty of the law.

On motion Ordered that Holliman Wheeler the County Surveyor be instructed to survey and mark off the dimensions of said lot preparatory to fencing the same, and to planting it in shade trees and also that he the said Surveyor lay off the Foundation for the Jailors Residence, and the limits of the Fence which is intended to include the jail since the said Jailors Residence.

The Board executed a Bond to the County of Douglas with good and sufficient sureties, that he will during the Spring inclose said County lot upon which the Jail stands with a good and erect Fence and plant said lot in shade trees free of cost to the County, provided, the Buildings upon said lot be removed within thirty days.

The Board made the following Order to wit: That in cases where lands have been sold to the County upon which any school District may have a school District Tax unpaid, and which has been taxed upon the Tax Roll of the County, as Delinquent School District Tax, The School District Treasurer shall upon application to the County Treasurer receive from him a Certificate of the amount due his District and present the same to the Board of County Commissioners for payment.

Upon application of the Township Trustee of Seecompton Township for means to defray the expense of supporting the Poor of said Township the Board appropriated \$30.43 for such purpose.

Upon application of the Township Trustee of Clinton Township \$40.00 was appropriated for the support of the poor of said Township.

The Board of J. W. Evans Deputy County Assessor for the Year 1863 was appointed. The Board of S. F. Evans was presented and appointed as Deputy County Assessor for the Year 1863.
