

The Petition of J. D. Thacher to wit: I pray to publish in the Severn the ensuing Year free of cost to the County the Printing of your Books together with all advertisements required by you to be published on behalf of the County, on condition that you advance to me the publishing at legal rates of the delinquent Tax Lists as well as the notices required by law to be published by County Treasurers of lands, and lots sold for Taxes, and condemned, including in the above all publications respecting Tax sales and tax redemption all of which is respectfully submitted.

 J. B. McIntosh proposed to sell and Iron safe to the County for the County Treasurers Office "W. B. Jennings Safe" for \$150.00 Cash which proposition was accepted, and approved by the Board, and J. H. Pearson Chairman, appointed to complete the trade.

Lucius M. Jones made application for the abatement of Taxes upon the 6th & 7th sections 28 Township 13, Range 20 for the Year 1862 to the amount of \$15.00 which was approved.

J. B. McIntosh made application for the abatement of Tax upon personal Property for the Years 1861 and 1862, upon consideration of which, the Board abated the Tax upon his personal property of the Year 1861, but refused to abate the Tax on his personal property of 1862.

William Bryman made application for abatement of Tax upon personal property of 1862 all of which was abated owing to illegal assessment.

Edward Smith made application for the abatement of tax for the Year 1862 on personal Property to the value of \$600.00 upon the ground that that amount was illegally assessed, the said \$600.00 having come into his possession after the 1st day of April, which application was approved.

On Motion Chas. Dickson, was appointed to superintend the erection of the Jailers Residence Contracted for by Oliver Pease.

On Motion the Board abated the Tax for the Year 1868 upon Lot N^o 19 Massachusetts Street said lot being now occupied by the County provided the lot be assessed for the Year 1868 and the Tax of said Year be paid by November.

On Motion the Order abating the Tax upon lot N^o 19 Massachusetts Street for the Year 1868 was rescinded.

On Motion, Ordered that the County Clerk issue County Orders to the amount of accounts audited at this meeting of the Board.
