 said Roads and Surveyors to meet at the house of John
 Anderson Monday July 20th 1863 10 o'clock A.M. to make
 the view and location of said road, if deemed advisable
 for the public interest.

The Bill of C. H. Vanhousen Township Trustee of Willow-
 Springs Township for the support of the Poor of said Township
 audited at \$60.00
