The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment, present F. Gleason Chairman, Chas. Jackson and John Campbell Commissioners, and Geo W Bell County Clerk

Fortunatus Gleason was appointed a committee to procure a Building suitable for County Purposes

The Board appropriated \$25.00 to compensate Samuel A. Kingsley for his services in collecting the delinquent Army Service of John Baldwin of the Examiner Army

The City Authorities of Cadoux City presented a Petition for an appropriation of \$500.00 for the repair of the Cadoux Bridge across the Muskogee Creek which on motion was laid over until the next meeting of the Board
