Board met pursuant to adjournment. Members all present.
 On motion the account in the bill of Wm G. G. G. in the
 case of "State of Kansas vs. Smith & Gaffney of Four (4) Dollars
 and 75c was ordered allowed at Two (2) Dollars. On motion the bill
 of M. A. Smith County Assessor amounting to Three Hundred and
 Sixty Dollars was ordered allowed and paid. On motion it was
 ordered that the Road Viewers of a road petitioned for by Wm C
 Barnes and others be laid over until a duplicate petition be
 furnished and that the County Clerk be instructed to require
 such duplicate petition of said petitioners. On motion the bill
 of W. J. Barber Clerk Assessor of One Hundred and Twenty (120)
 Dollars was ordered allowed and paid. On motion the bill
 of County Clerk of Four (4) Dollars was ordered allowed and
 paid. On motion ordered that Board adjourn until 10 o'clock
 P.M.

Laurens Oct 14th 1863 10 o'clock P.M.
 Board called to order by the Chairman. Members all
 present. On motion ordered that the bill of J. C. Campbell of
 Forty Eight (48) Dollars be allowed and paid. On motion ordered
 that the bill of Chas. Dickson of Twenty (20) Dollars be allowed
 and paid. On motion ordered that the bill of J. Gleason
 of Fifty one (51) Dollars be allowed and paid. On motion ordered
 that the report of the Viewers of the Laurens and Parker road
 be laid over to the adjourned meeting of the Board.
 On motion ordered that One Hundred (100) Dollars be
 appropriated to Mrs. Bell. The amount of the bill of Wm
 Bell County Clerk received audited and allowed him on
 the 20th day of August last which was destroyed and now
 remains unpaid. On motion it was ordered that all
 County Officers and Justices of the Peace be required to renew
 their official bonds within thirty days.
 On motion the following preamble and resolution was ordered
 passed.

Whereas the general indices of the office of Register
 of Deeds of this County were destroyed by fire in the
 recent raid upon Laurens.

Therefore on motion Ordered That
 James C. Horton Register of Deeds of said County be authorized
 and instructed to make new indices for said records
 and that he be allowed as compensation therefor the sum of
 Eighty cents for indexing each instrument upon said records
 payable out of the County Treasury...

On motion ordered that Board adjourn until the first
 Monday of December 1863 at 10 o'clock A.M.
