granted - Also on petition of Prof. P. A. Coney certificate granted
to enable M. J. Bessenth a deaf mute orphan to receive the
State aid in such cases provided.

On motion ordered that an
appropriation of \$11.26 be made to Dennis Milley on account of
Erroneous assessment in School District said Milley having
paid the assessment.
