Friday One O'clock P.M.

Board met pursuant to adjournment R. G. Elliott Late Treasurer turned over to the Board County orders to the amount of Seventeen hundred and seventy seven dollars and seventy two cents (\$1777.72) which were cancelled by the Board and destroyed in presence of the full board R. G. Elliott and Paul R. Brooks County Clerk. a list of the orders thus destroyed were placed on file according to Law.

On motion ordered that an appropriation of \$5.37 be made to L. J. Dallas on account of illegal school District Tax on the S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 19 Township 14 Range 20.

On certificate of W. M. Nace Trustee of Lecompton Township an appropriation of \$8.50 was made to said Trustee for support of illegitimate child in said Township up to May 4th 1864.

The report of Samuel Reynolds Trustee of Wakarusa Township of the receipts and expenditures of said Township for the year 1863-64 was examined and approved.

On Application of W. M. Bowman an appropriation of \$9.76 was made to him for illegal sale of Land for Taxes.
