Board met pursuant to adjournment

The following resolution was offered, and on motion adopted.

Whereas in the opinion of this Board the wants of Douglas  
County demand that a County Asylum should be pro-  
vided for the Paupers of the County and that a great saving  
would thereby be made to the County as well as a large amount  
of comfort secured to that unfortunate class. And whereas the  
Law of the State require that the question of erecting any perma-  
nent County buildings shall be submitted to a vote of the  
electors of the County. Therefore resolved by the Board of  
Commissioners of Douglas County that Notice shall be  
given according to law that at the general election to be  
held in November 1864 the question of purchasing a tract of  
land and erecting suitable buildings for a County Asylum for  
the Poor at a cost not to exceed one and one half mills on the  
dollar of the total valuation of the taxable property of the  
County will be submitted to the voters of the County  
and the Clerk is hereby directed to make the necessary public-  
cation and notices, according to law in the name of  
the Commissioners.

On Motion ordered that James Blood  
County Treasurer, Samuel A. Riggs District Attorney, and  
Paul R. Brooks County Clerk be appointed a committee to  
examine the final report of R.G. Elliott County Treasurer
