

Lawrence Kansas October 3 1864
Board of Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to Law Present
Commissioners Gleason (Chairman) Dickson and Barricklow and
Paul R. Brooks County Clerk.

Minutes of previous meetings of the Board
read and approved

The Report of the viewers of a road petitioned for
by H. L. Enns and others commencing at a point in the Western boundary
of the Shawnee Reservation where said line intersects the North line of the
South West Quarter of Section Eleven (11) Town Thirteen (13) S. Range Twenty
(20) E. was presented and read and on motion ordered that the
road be located and established according to the report of the
viewers and field notes accompanying said report filed in the Office
of the County Clerk August 6. 1864.

A petition was presented by Thomas
McHort S. G. Johnson and others for the establishing a road commence-
ing at the centre of the East line of the S. E. 1/4 of Section one (1) Township
Thirteen (13) Range Nineteen (19) running thence due west one mile.
and it appearing to the Board that the petitioners have complied
with the Law it was Ordered that Messrs F. Fuller Ruben Rawdall
and Martin Adams be appointed Viewers, and Holland Wheeler
Surveyor, to meet at the house of Samuel Reynolds on the 12th day
of November 1864 at ten o'clock a.m. to view and survey said
road.

A Report from the Commissioners of a State Road from the Dept
to the Ferry on the Kansas River at the Town of Eudora in Douglas Coun-
ty from thence to the Town of Black Jack was presented and read
and on motion ordered that the road be opened according to
the field notes accompanying said report.

The Bills of the Commission-
ers of the above road were laid over for explanation the amounts
exceeding what the Law allows.

The report of the Commissioners of
a State road running from Lawrence via Eudora, Desoto and
Shawnee to the State line at or near Kansas City Mo. was pre-
sented and on motion ordered that the part of said road
running through this County be opened. The following
bills of Commissioners of said road were allowed

On motion ordered that a Certificate be granted to Gordon Neal
to enable his daughter a deaf mute to attend the school for deaf
mutes and receive the State aid in such case provided.

Bill of Holland Wheeler for making maps of Douglas County
was presented and allowed, amount \$50.00

On motion adjourned
until tomorrow morning at 9 o'clock
