A Bill was presented from the City of Lawrence amounting to \$1296.95 for the support of Paupers from March 6th 1862 to July 6 1864.

On motion ordered that the bill be allowed at eight hundred and fifty dollars and that the order on the Treasury be drawn payable on the first day of May A.D. 1865.

A petition was presented by C. Robinson, Agent asking for an abatement of tax on land assessed to Martha Robinson in Wakarusa Township being one hundred acres in the west 1/2 & S.W. corner of the S.E. quarter of Section Thirty six (36) Township Twelve (12) Range Nineteen (19) also asking an abatement of tax on lots in Blocks Two (2) Three (3) and Eight (8) in the City of Lawrence and it appearing to the Board that injustice had been done in assessing said property it was on motion ordered that an abatement of \$38.75 be made on the tax of said land in Wakarusa Township and that the sum of \$23.34 be abated on the tax of lots in Blocks Two (2) Three (3) and Eight (8) in the City of Lawrence.

On motion ordered that the clerk be instructed to advertise for proposals for wood for the use of the County for the coming year.

On motion ordered that the Treasurer be requested to report to the Board the condition of the Treasury together with the receipts and disbursements from July 12th 1864 to January 1 1865 at their meeting on the first Monday in January 1865.

It was further ordered that the clerk be instructed to prepare a report of the receipts and expenditures of the County for the year 1864.
