Board met pursuant to adjournment present full Board.

Mr Bryant presented a petition asking that the sum of \$4.51 be refunded to him on account of District School Tax paid by him and which was placed on the Tax rolls through error. On motion ordered that the sum of \$4.51 be refunded to said D. Bryant and charged to School Dist. No 26 Clinton Township.

The report of the viewers of a Road petitioned for by Joel Grover and others in Warranisa Township was taken up.

Mr Dickson moved that the road be established according to said viewers report as follows - Commencing at the Quarter Section corner between Sections 35 & 36 Town 12 - Range 19 East Thence East on Quarter Sec. line 21.50 Chains Thence North $22\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E. 12.12 Chains Thence North 51° East 10.50 Chains Thence East 5.76 Chains to East line of Quarter Section. (Note = A part of the road recommended in the viewers report was established August 28 1864)

The yeas and nays were called for and ordered Messrs Dickson and Barnicklow voting for the motion and Mr Cleason against - and the motion was carried.

The Commissioners proceeded to open proposals for wood which had been put in in the notice of the Clerk Mc H. Berry having put in the lowest bid to cut \$3.98 per cord it was ordered that the contract be given to said Berry.

A report was presented from the Commissioners of a State road from Lawrence to the North line of Bourbon County - The Clerk was instructed to notify the proper owners to have said Road opened according to the report of the Commissioners. The sum of \$43.50 was appropriated for pay of said Commissioners.

On motion ordered that the sum of \$50 be appropriated to the Commissioners of a State road running from the Depot on the Pacific Rail Road to the Ferry on the Kansas River opposite Eudora thence to the Town of Dicks in Douglas County said report having been filed in the Clarks office July 14 1864.

The petition of William Hughes for vacating certain Streets Alleys in the town of Bloomington was taken up and the 16th day of February set as the day on which Harris interested for or against said petition will be heard.
