

Wilder in Section 36 Town 12, Range 17 and running West on the quarter section line to the S.W. corner of the N.W. quarter of said section 36 thence in a North Westerly direction to a point on the California Road 35 in Town 12, Range 17, was taken up and on motion G.W. Goss and Lewis Anderson were appointed to view said proposed road & meet with the County surveyor at the Wind Mill of Wilder and Palm on the 6th day of March A.D. 1865 at ten o'clock A.M.

A. Lewis presented Estimate (as Overseer of Poor Clinton Township) of \$70

On Motion ordered that the sum of \$70. be appropriated for support of Poor in Clinton Township up to April 1st 1865

A petition was presented and read asking that J.S. Brown be appointed to fill the vacancy in the office of County Superintendent of Public Instruction. On Motion Ordered that J.S. Brown be appointed County Superintendent of Public Instruction to fill vacancy occasioned by failure of Hanes Craig to file Oath of Office.

On Motion adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.

The petition of Mr. S. Hughes was taken up asking for the vacating of certain structures in Bloomington and it appearing that proper notice had not been given to the several parties interested, it was on Motion ordered that the 4th day of April at one o'clock P.M. be set as the time when the Board will hear the parties and that the Clerk cause the proper notices to be published.

The following resolution was offered and adopted

Resolved that the County Treasurer be instructed to present to the Board at its meeting in April a statement of account between the County and the City of Lawrence in order that a settlement can be effected with said City of Lawrence.

Mr. W. Haseltine Administrator of the Estate of L.S. Angell presented a petition asking that an abatement be made of the assessment of personal property of L.S. Angell and it appearing to the Board that said assessment was illegal it was on Motion abated (Amount \$40.00)

On Motion ordered that the Clerk be instructed to notify the Treasurer that the restriction in regard to the transfer of
