

Laurence Monday April 3 1865

The Board of Commissioners met pursuant to Law Present Commissioners Gleason & Barnicklow and Paul O Brooks County Clerk
Minutes of Meetings of February 16th & 17th Read and approved.

This being the day set by Law for canvassing the returns of the Township Election the Board on motion adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.

9 O'clock a.m. April 4 1865

Board met pursuant to adjournment Present full Board.

The Board proceeded to select a list of persons to serve as Grand and Petit Jurors for the ensuing year. after which Board adjourned until one o'clock P.M.

A petition was presented signed by Asa Darnell and others asking that a change be made in the Fort Scott Road leading from Lawrence to the Frankfort County line and it appearing to the Board that legal publications had been made it was on motion ordered that Philip Muters Michael Rothrock, and E. W. Vainhansen be appointed to view the proposed change to meet at the house of Asa Darnell on the 19th day of April 1865 at ten o'clock A.M.

A petition was presented signed by W. Altbund and others asking that a road be located and established commencing at the South East corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 35. Town 12. Range 19 thence North on said quarter section line to the Kansas River. and in the opinion of the Board the Public wants not requiring a road at the point petitioned for it was ordered that the petition be rejected.

The report of the survey on the Road petitioned for by John Wilder and others commencing at the S.W. corner of land owned by J. H. Wilder in Sec. 36. Town 12 Range 19 and running West on the 1/4 sec. line to the S.W. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of said Section 36. thence in a North Westerly direction to a point on the California Road, where said Road angles to the North West. between Sections 26 & 35 in Town 12. Range 19. was taken up and on motion the Road was ordered to be established according to said report filed in the County Clerks office March 14 1865 Damages were allowed T. J. Fernell to the amount of \$150.00

This being the time set for taking testimony in the matter of the Petition of Wm Hughes asking for certain Lots to be vacated in the town of Bloomington and it appearing to the Board that no inhabitants owning any of the soil protect against said petition being granted, a Certificate was made and Plat as required by Law and filed with the County Recorder

A petition was presented signed by Thos. H. Chells and 13 others asking that a road be established as follows to wit: commencing at a point on the Section line between Sections 34 & 27 Town 12 Range 19 half way between the N.E. & N.W. corner
