The minutes of the meeting of the board of April 17th were read and approved.

The report of the survey of a proposed road petitioned for by Thomas R. Wells and others was read and on motion adopted being a house to the location of the road.

The petition of John Which and others for the location of a certain road was taken up and it appearing to the Board that the petitioners had complied with the law in regard to publication. It was Ordered that Henry Webber Thomas Bault Samuel W. Webster be appointed to view the proposed route to meet with the County Surveyor for that purpose at the house of John Which on the 5th day of July at ten o'clock A.M.

A petition was presented signed by Daniel Pitts Auger and others asking for the location of a certain road. And it appearing to the Board that legal publication had been made. It was on motion ordered that W. H. Coates, Geo. Dutton & J. W. Shepherd be appointed to view said proposed road to meet with the County Surveyor for that purpose at the house of C. Black on the 1st day of August 1865 at ten o'clock A.M.

Board adjourned until One o'clock P.M.

The County Assessor ^{reported} that Messrs C. Dickson and William Morrow appointed and approved by the board as assistants in taking the 1st State census had declined to serve and that he had appointed Messrs R. L. Gilbert and P. H. Tuttle and asked that they be approved by the Board. On motion Messrs Gilbert & Tuttle appointed were approved.

On motion being made that all that part of the tax of 1864 which was brought from the tax rolls of 1863, on all of those lots in the Town of Leominster on which the Trustees of Lane University hold certificates of sale for taxes of previous years, be remitted to said Trustees. The assessor was recalled for Messrs Dickson & Barnicklow being absent. On motion adjourned until tomorrow morning at nine o'clock.
